

Membership application – Regional Member

About the Alliance

The Alliance to End Plastic Waste (“Alliance”) is a U.S. registered 501(c)(3) public charity with a mission to help end plastic waste in the environment. Supported by a community of pioneering business leaders dedicated to building a circular economy for plastic, the Alliance includes member companies from across the plastic value chain. Working together, we are shaping and investing into pathways to a sustainable future.

Regional membership eligibility

Any company may apply to join the Alliance as a “Regional Member”, provided a substantial portion¹ of its business includes:

- manufacturing chemicals or plastic resin;
- manufacturing, selling, or using products made from or packaged using plastic, including consumer goods companies and retailers;
- converting plastic resin into finished products, managing municipal solid waste, or recycling or recovering used plastics; or
- producing goods or providing services that enable or support the functioning of the plastic value chain, but does not directly involve manufacturing plastic, manufacturing or selling goods made from or packaged using plastic, or managing municipal solid waste.

Regional membership commitment and obligations

Regional member companies agree to support the Alliance’s mission in several ways. First, they contribute membership dues every year directly to the Alliance for use in its Solution Accelerator Fund. Second, they commit to invest into their own activities targeting the elimination of plastic waste as part of the Alliance’s Member Directed Commitments (MDC). (The membership dues and MDC levels for Regional Members are set at 60% of those for a full Member.) Member companies also frequently volunteer company time, resources and expertise to support the work of the Alliance.

Regional members do not qualify as full members of the Alliance’s Board of Directors. However, a Regional Member is eligible to nominate a Representative who may attend Board meetings in an observer capacity, but does not have a voting right.

In addition, Regional Member companies agree:

- To ensure that staff members of their company practice the highest standards of business

ethics, and adhere to all applicable Alliance by-laws, policies, procedures and terms of reference applicable to all Alliance members, including the Alliance's policies and procedures on anti-trust, conflicts of interest, anti-bribery and anti-corruption, when participating in Alliance-related activities.

- That their company's name and logo may be used by the Alliance to identify the company as an Alliance member in Alliance-related materials and media (online, print, radio, or television) communications.

Regional membership term

The term of my company's commitment shall commence on 1 February 2022, and shall continue thereafter for the commitment period indicated below ("Term").

Following the initial Term, membership of the Alliance extends automatically by one year every year. The one-year extension is made 12 months before a member's Term expires. Member companies receive two months' notice of the automatic extension, during which time they may elect to terminate their membership and cancel the extension.²

² For example: A company chose to join the Alliance for a two-year Term at Board level, running from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2023.

- Membership automatically extends for an additional year on 1 Jan 2023, extending the membership Term to 31 December 2024.
- Notification of the extension is sent to the member on 1 November 2022. If the member company wishes to cancel its membership, it must notify the Alliance before 31 December 2022. The membership would then terminate on 31 December 2023, as per the original membership commitment. Deviations can, at any time, be allowed with approval of the Board officers of the Alliance.

After the initial Term is served, membership of the Alliance extends automatically by one year (unless notice is served not to renew). For every subsequent one-year Term, my company will invest the following minimum annual value in MDC:

US\$180,000
Value of annual MDC after Initial term is served

Member Directed Commitment projects must meet each of these criteria:

- **Objectives** – project outcomes must directly align to at least one of the four Alliance pillars (Infrastructure, Innovation, Education and Engagement, or Clean-up);
- **Additionality** – the project must be after the date of joining the Alliance to be counted towards Member Directed Commitment, and in addition to business-as-usual scenarios;
- **Materiality** – the project must be intended to lead to reduction or avoidance of unmanaged and/or mismanaged plastic waste into the environment; and
- **External impact** – the project must have impact beyond improving a member's own operations, product, packaging design/optimisation, and/or other internal commitments.

A member company may elect to meet its Member Directed Commitment by contributing dues of an equal value to the Alliance's Solution Accelerator Fund.
